To ensure the fulfilment of all the above stated objectives and for intellectual stimulation we keep on organizing various Seminars and Workshops.

Besides the in-house workshops which are taken by our expert faculties, we invite experts from various streams from time to time to share their knowledge and/or skills with the students. In the academic year 2018-19 the following workshops have been conducted for our students:

- Pidilite workshop

The Pidilite workshop was for art and craft, because of the inputs from the workshops the students made innovative teaching aids and also made their internship files appealing and attractive.

- Flipped Classroom workshop

The flipped classroom workshop was conducted by our trained faculty members. The students took the lessons after this workshop in their respective internship institutes.

- Lesson Plan workshop

The lesson plan workshop was conducted for the students before sending them for the second phase of internship.

- Evaluation Workshop

The evaluation workshop included orientation for year plan, unit plan, question bank, weightage table, blue print, unit test, answer key, scoring key and marking scheme.

- Models of Teaching

The Students were oriented to different models of teaching. The faculty members gave model lessons of the models of teaching in simulation and also provided the learners with sample lesson plan.

- Fire Safety

The fire safety workshop was organized by the Head Office of Universal groups for our students. The students were made aware of the four different fire extinguishers, how to use them, when to use them, which type of fire requires a particular type of extinguisher. The workshop was a huge success because the Students got to see the demonstration of two types of fire extinguishers and also they tried out the fire extinguishers.
