




TALENT SEARCH EVENT




HEALTHIFY WITH YOGA









MARATHI DIVAS




WOMEN'S DAY

The first day's event where the theme was **Spontaneous speech**, where a flippity wheel was used to select the famous women personalities.




WOMEN'S DAY


DEBATE PARTICIPANTS

HOLI & GOOD FRIDAY






TEACHER'S DAY & GANESH CHATURTHI







The librarian conducted a quiz on **'The life sketch of Gandhi'**.




VACHAN PRERNA DIWAS

ACADEMICS



Shadowing with LUCE Alumni (23rd July - 26th July 2021)

Lessons supervised by past students in the role of the shadow teachers- As per the B. Ed. syllabus in the first phase of practice teaching, students are to be deputed in school without providing any training for playing the teacher's role. The idea of the **shadowing internship** is to observe and learn the school culture of academic activities and reflect upon their takeaways, uninfluenced by B. Ed. training. However, due to the present crisis, the schools were reluctant to allow student-teachers to observe the teacher's daily teaching schedules. Hence, LUCE had decided to schedule the shadowing session with alumni of LUCE who are working in different schools.

It was a wonderful teaching-learning experience for all our students who got an opportunity to interact and learn on a one-to-one basis from their shadow mentors. The current batch of students got an opportunity to connect with Alumni and learn from each other. This could help them in incorporating this take aways in second phase of training when they are doing it actually.



Collaboration with Faculty Of Education and Humanities, Manav Rachana University NOIDA, Haryana (FOEH MRU)

Between 3rd — 7th Aug 2021, LUCE collaborated with B. Ed college of Manav Rachna University, Noida, as a week of Internship for the students.

In the collaboration, planning and implementation have the subsequent and successive steps that were followed by both **LUCE and FOEH MRU**.

Every lecture was followed by constructive feedback from supervisors of both institutes. Each student got an opportunity to deliver one lecture and learn a lot in the entire session.

The Students then took the remaining lessons within the groups in the simulated set-up to complete the 1st phase of their Internship.




What Is Intervention in Education?

Many teachers engage in remediation regularly as a natural part of instruction, without using a formal process or even explicitly recognizing their actions as







INTRA COLLEGIATE
