

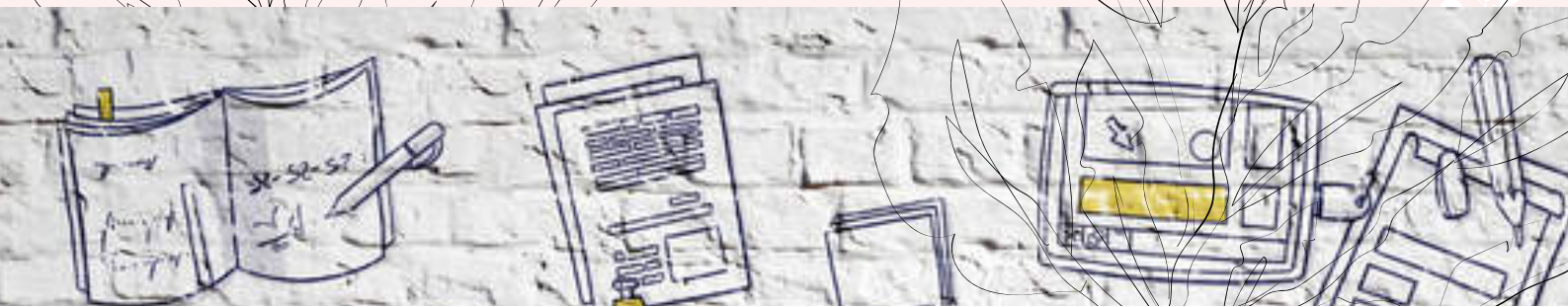

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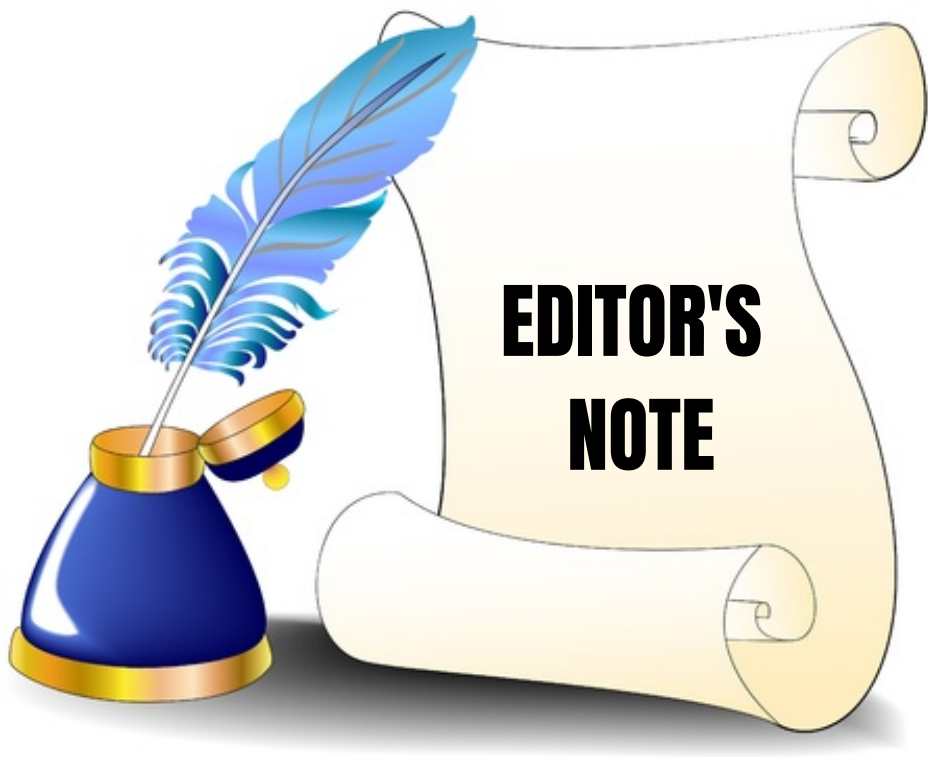

INTERNSHIP



During our second semester, our internship in schools was for a period of 3 weeks starting from the **18th of July 2022 to the 5th of August 2022**. Before our internship started we had an “Orientation program” in our college by our teachers who gave us a broad overview of the internship program, what we are expected to do, and how we should conduct ourselves on school premises.

The entire class was divided into different groups according to the schools allotted to them. Each group was assigned a Group leader who will coordinate between the internship school, their teammates, and our college. We were assigned to different streams like **ICSE, SSC private schools, schools run by BMC, and junior colleges** were assigned to students who have completed their Master's degree.

We were assigned **Shadow Teachers** in our respective schools and we were asked to complete Shadow Teaching sessions, **Peer observation sessions**, and our own sessions where we had to teach the class on the topic assigned to us. Every session we took was supervised by our teachers who would sit through the session and observe us. We used different types of **teaching aids** to make the session interesting. Some of them were **charts, models, PowerPoint presentations, crosswords, quizzes and games**. After each session, our teacher would ask us to reflect upon our session and add their comments on how to improve it effectively.

On the last day of our internship, every group prepared **handmade greeting cards** as a token of thank you to our respective schools and our shadow teachers. The entire internship was an enriching experience as we got to know the working of a school and how efficient and effective a teacher should be to help the students in every possible way.

On **5th July 2022** Tuesday, we had a session with the counselor on 'Personal counseling and significance of counseling on teachers' by the resource person **Meenakshi Thakkar** where she explain to us the significance of counseling for Teachers followed by that on **6th July 2022** Wednesday ma'am took a second session on 'importance of counseling for student-teachers.

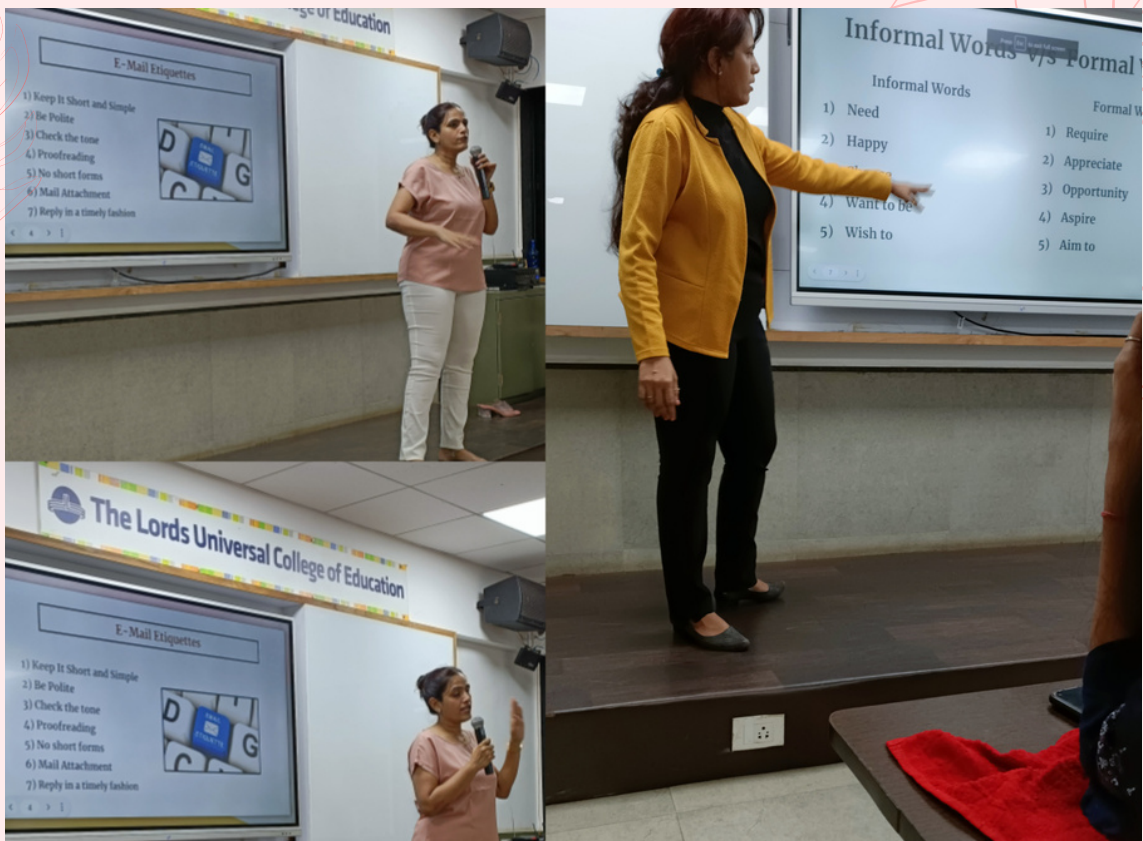
INTRA COLLEGE COMPETITIONS

ORIENTATION ON FINANCIAL LITERACY BY PARESH SETH



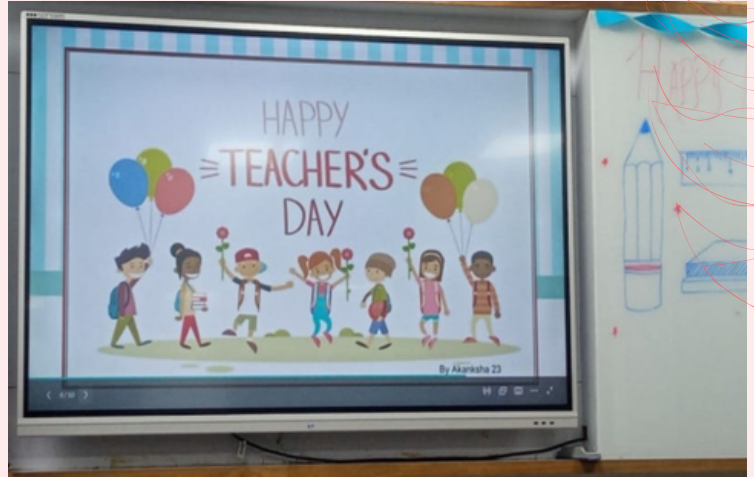

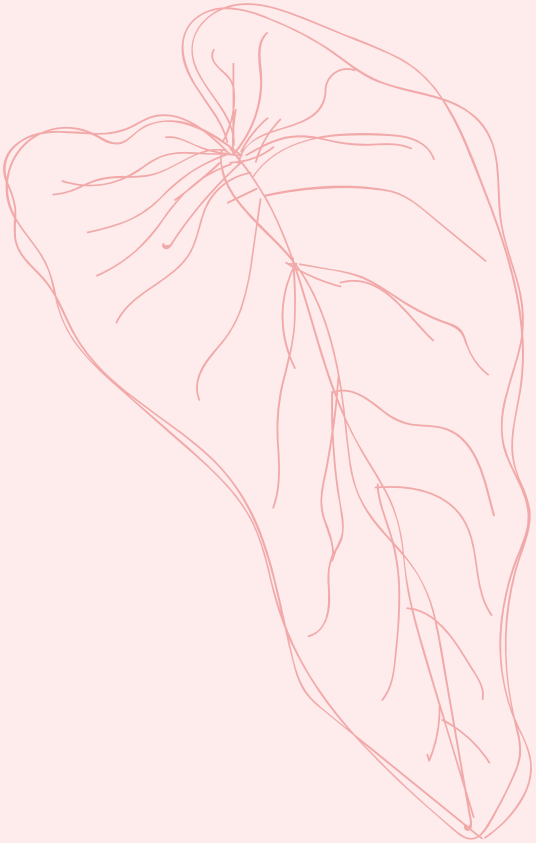
